

## Safety Protocol Windshield Survey

- Arrive by car at physical activity resource
- Drive around resource perimeter
- Survey entire area visually from locked car
- If outside conditions appear unsafe, do not leave the vehicle. Proceed to next PA resource
- If conditions appear safe, proceed with assessment
- If at any time conditions become unsafe, return to vehicle. Proceed to next assessment
- Telephone supervisor

#### Feature-#13 Baseball Field

**Poor**-Surface of fields is uneven, unsafe, no overhead lighting, no benches for players, fencing in poor condition or nonexistent



#### Feature-#13 Baseball Field

 Mediocre-Surface of fields is uneven, slightly unsafe, no overhead lighting, benches for dugouts. Some fencing exists, but not 100% intact





#### Feature#13-Baseball Field

 Good-Surface of fields is uniform, no rocks/barriers to running bases, have overhead lighting, benches for dugouts. Have bleachers for spectators, intact backstop fencing



#### Feature #14-Basketball Court

 Poor-Hoop of court is in very bad condition, almost unstable



#### Feature #14-Basketball Court

 Mediocre-Hoop is missing a net, rim is bent, court has cracks or weeds



#### Feature #14-Basketball Court

 Good-Hoop is straight and has a net or chain, court is playable



#### Feature #15-Soccer Field

Poor-Grass coverage may be poor in 50% or >
 of the field, rough surface, hazards and/or
 trash on the field



#### Feature #15-Soccer Field

 Mediocre-Grass coverage may be sparse in a few places or surface may have a few cracks, grass may be too high, some trash or debris

on field



#### Feature #15-Soccer Field

 Good-Field has uniform grass coverage and is well-mowed, no trash or debris on field; nets, if furnished, are intact



#### Feature #16-Bike Rack

 Poor-Rack is in meager condition, almost unstable or has poor access



#### Feature #16-Bike Rack

 Mediocre-Rack is bent, or missing paint, but otherwise usable



#### Feature #16-Bike Rack

 Good-Rack is sturdy, usable, may have a few cosmetic blemishes



# Feature #17-Exercise Stations with Signage (Exer. Station)

 Poor-4 or > stations need major repair-are not safe to use. Signage may be missing or in poor condition for several stations. Path between stations is unsafe.

### Feature #17-Exercise Stations with Signage

 Mediocre-3 or < stations may need minor repair or maintenance, path between stations needs minor improvement



### Feature #17-Exercise Stations with Signage

 Good-Stations themselves are in good condition and safe, 5 or > stations with path safe between them



## Feature #18-Play Equipment

- Describe if different than traditional play equipment (slide, swings, monkey bars).
- Poor-Several pieces are in need of major repair and is almost unstable, there is a lot of trash, and the ground is overgrown or barren



# Feature #18-Play Equipment

 Mediocre-Some equipment is in need of minor repair, there is some trash, and the ground needs some improvement



## Feature #18-Play Equipment

 Good-In good condition, variety of pieces, ground in good condition, well-kept and clean



#### Feature #19-Pool

 Poor-Swimming pool has very discolored water or too little water, surrounding surface is in need of repair, trash in or around poolnot safe for use



#### Feature #19-Pool

 Mediocre-Swimming pool or deck needs minor cleaning or treatment



#### Feature #19-Pool

 Good-Swimming pool is clean, well-lit, surrounding surface is safe as well as exit/entry points



#### Feature #20-Sandbox

 Poor-Sandbox is < or ½ full, and/or needs cleaning (replacement sand). Box itself needs major repair, and is almost unusable.



#### Feature #20-Sandbox

 Good-Sandbox has adequate clean sand, all sides/edging are sturdy and there are safe places for children to sit.



#### Feature #21-Sidewalk

 Poor-Sidewalk has major damage and needs repair, almost unusable



### Feature #21-Sidewalk

 Mediocre-Sidewalk has some debris, cracks or uneven surfaces, but otherwise usable



#### Feature #22-Tennis Courts

 Poor-Courts have cracked surface, nets are in major need of repair, debris is evident; almost unusable



#### Feature #22-Tennis Courts

 Mediocre-Court surface and nets are in need of some repair, but otherwise usable



#### Feature #22-Tennis Courts

 Good-Tennis court surface and nets are in fairly good condition



### Feature #23-Trails: Running/Biking

 Poor-Surface is unsafe in many places, there is a lot of debris, no signage about appropriate use



### Feature #23-Trails: Running/Biking

 Mediocre-Surface in places uneven or in need of minor repair, may be a few hazards or avoidable debris



### Feature #23-Trails: Running/Biking

 Good-Surface is smooth, without unmarked hazards or debris, has signage re: appropriate users



## Feature #24-Volleyball Courts

 Poor-Playing surface has debris or cracks or bumps all over, net is almost unusable or missing



## Feature #24-Volleyball Courts

 Mediocre-Playing surface has some debris or cracks or has 1-5 bumps, net is sagging or has holes



## Feature #24-Volleyball Courts

 Good-Playing surface is free of debris, and smooth, net is in good condition



## Feature #25-Wading Pool <3ft.

 Poor-Wading pool has discolored water, or no water, trash in or around pool-not safe for use



# Feature #25-Wading Pool <3ft.

 Mediocre-Wading pool needs minor cleaning or repair



# Feature #25-Wading Pool <3ft.

Good-Wading pool is clean and well-kept
